California based company Kepler Motors will unveil an all new supercar called MOTION at the Dubai Motor Show end of this week.

The MOTION is an all-wheel-drive hybrid that is powered by a modified 550 hp Ford EcoBoost twin-turbo 3.5-liter V6 powering rear wheels, on the front is a 250 hp electric motor making the total output an impressive 800 hp.
